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
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MESSAGES

bject: Accreditation of Obsts. / Gynae discipline for FCPS training at HITEC-Institute of Medical Sciences, Taxila.

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We are pleased to inform you that (in accordance with the laid down rules and regulations for accreditation of training programmes), the College of Physicians & Surgeons Pakistan, on the basis of physical re-inspection conducted on January 18th, 2024 and after confirmation of rectification of deficiencies has decided to accord accreditation to HITEC-Institute of Medical Sciences, Taxila for FCPS training as under:

Obsts. / Gynae:
 Accreditation for FCPS training.

For continuation of accreditation status, re-inspection is mandatory after 05 years for maintenance of improvement. It is the responsibility of head of the institution to apply for re-visit at least 3 months before expiry of accreditation status.

The accreditation of the institution is valid subject to availability of R&RC registered supervisor & strict compliance with the following conditions.

- 1) The induction of trainees must be as per CPSP policy.
- 2) The training period must be supervised and registered. Trainees are required to be registered with the Registration & Research Cell (R&RC) of the College within 30 days of commencement of their training. This is mandatory requirement falling which R&RC will refuse registration.
- The R&RC (CPSP) should be informed regarding the transfer / posting of the supervisor consultants and ensure the training of the trainees in not affected.
- Proper & updated maintenance of the E-Log in accordance with the CPSP guidelines & quarterly performance report.
- Every trainee must be paid stipend for training at par with that paid by the Federal / Provincial Governments. Honorary training is not allowed.
- 6) No tuition or any other fee will be charged from the trainees

A total of 33 participants attended the workshop from Khyber College of Dentistry Peshawar, Margalla College of Dentistry, Watim Dental College Aero Hospital and Dental

College HITEC-IMS. 04 CME credit hours were awarded by the National University of Medical Sciences.

This activity comprised of interactive lectures on considerations of critical anatomical structures, surgical techniques, complications of implants dental and their management, demonstration on CBCT imaging, hands-on practice of implant placement on D2 bone simulators.





WORKSHOP ON PRESCRIPTION WRITING AND P-DRUG

A workshop on Prescription writing and P -drug was conducted by the Pharmacology department on 30th January 2024. Prof Muhammad Munir Ahmad Khan (Head of Pharmacology Department) talked about the parts of a prescription, importance of rational prescribing of a drug and common errors in prescription writing.
