1.0 PURPOSE:

This policy aims to streamline the admissions process, ensuring fairness, transparency, equal opportunity for all aspiring candidates and bridge communication gaps between NUMS and colleges. The Centralized Admissions Policy encompasses procedures and guidelines to be followed for admissions, including the application process, selection criteria, fee payment, and handling of special category seats The policy is formulated in accordance with NUMS Admission Policy 2024. Only NUMS MDCAT is applicable for admission in NUMS affiliated & constituted colleges.

2.0 SCOPE:

This procedure is applicable to Student Affairs Department for admission.

5.0 PROCEDURE

5.1 PM&DC RULING

"National University of Medical Sciences (NUMS) shall be the admitting university responsible for admissions in all Armed forces – administered medical / dental colleges / institutes.

5.2 SCOPE OF POLICY

NUMS Policy for Centralized Admissions for MBBD / BDS is applicable to all NUMS Affiliated and Military Administered Medical and Dental Colleges offering 5 years MBBS and 4 years BDS program respectively. This policy shall apply only for admission on Open Merit, Foreign Category. However, the admissions of wards of Army serving / retired will be processed by GHQ W&R Dte.

5.3 BENEFITS OF POLICY

- 5.3.1 <u>Stream Line Process.</u> Centralizing the admissions process at NUMS will streamline the entire procedure, reducing redundancy and eliminating unnecessary steps.
- 5.3.2 <u>Transparency and Fairness.</u> By overseeing the selection process and compiling merit lists, NUMS ensures transparency and fairness in admissions, fostering trust among candidates and colleges.
- 5.3.2 Reduced Communication Gaps. Conducting admissions centrally will minimize communication gaps between NUMS and affiliated / attached colleges, ensuring seamless coordination and efficient management of admission.
- 5.3.3 <u>Enhanced Accessibility.</u> A centralized admission system makes the process more accessible to candidates, providing them with a single point of contact for all inquires and updates related to admissions.
- 5.3.4 <u>Efficient Fee Management.</u> Collecting initial admission acceptance fee through NUMS simplifies fee management for both candidates and colleges.

5.4 KEY STEPS OF CENTRALIZED ADMISSIONS

- 5.4.1 MDCAT NUMS. Candidates must pass the MDCAT (NUMS) exam with minimum requirement as notified by the Pakistan Medical and dental Council (PM&DC) for admission to MBBS and BDS programs for that year.
- 5.4.2 Advertisement For Admission & Application Process. NUMS will advertise the centralized admissions in MBBS & BDS for all armed forces administered medical / dental colleges. Advertisement will be published in leading newspapers as well as on NUMS official website. Candidates will apply through online admission portal.
- 5.4.3 <u>Scrutiny of Applications & Documents.</u> NUMS admission office will carefully review all applications before display of merit lists.

5.5 GENERATION OF MERIT LISTS

- 5.5.1 Provisional Merit List. Provisional merit list will be prepared and displayed on NUMS website for errors and omissions. No change / correction will be made after display.
- 5.5.2 College Wise Selection List. College wise selection lists will be displayed on NUMS website as per candidate's merit and preference given while submitting application.
- 5.5.3 <u>Upgradation List.</u> Second and subsequent selection lists will fill any vacancies through the up-gradation process, which will be determined by candidate's merit and preference. Upgradation list will be displayed on every consecutive 3 working days.

5.6 PROVISIONAL ADMISSION

Selected candidates will submit Rs. 250,000/- to NUMS for provisional admission acceptance. The remaining fee and other dues must be paid by the candidate at the time of joining HITEC-IMS.

5.7 UPGRADATION

Only the candidates selected in previous list, who had deposited prescribed fee will be considered for up-gradation process in the subsequent lists. Those who do not deposit fee when selected in the first list will not be considered for future upgradation. The shift to college in higher preference on upgradation shall be compulsory and no exception will be taken under any circumstances.

5.8 FINAL SELECTION AND ADMISSION LIST

Final list of admitted candidates will be displayed on NUMS website and forwarded to all colleges after completion of admissions.

5.9 JOINING OF CANDIDATES IN RESPECTIVE COLLEGES

All candidates in the college wise final selection list will report to HITEC-IMS along with their original documents for verification. HITEC-IMS will issue joining instructions to the selected candidates and challan of remaining dues with deadline of minimum three working days for payment. Failure to submit fee in the college after joining will result in cancellation of admission.

HITEC-IMS will forward list of candidates to the university who timely deposit balance fee / other charges for finalization of admission. The colleges will also forward list of candidates to the university who do not deposit balance fee / other charges by due date for deletion of their names for further processing.

5.10 FEE TRANSFER TO COLLEGE

NUMS will transfer the initial fees amount (Rs. 250,000 per candidate) to respective colleges once confirmation from colleges is received about finalization of their admission.

5.12 OPEN MERIT & FOREIGN CATEGORY

- 5.12.1 Candidates who get selected in college of their preference will be issued a challan of Rs. 250,000 and Admission Offer letter through online admission portal
- 5.12.2 Candidates are not required to visit NUMS when selected.
- 5.12.3 Candidates will upload the copy of paid challan / payment proof through online admission portal within due date of fee submission. **NUMS Finance department** will confirm the payment the Admission Office before displaying the subsequent upgradation list.
- 5.12.4 Candidate if upgraded to his / her college of higher preference will be notified by NUMS automated system through email / SMS.

5.13 W&R QUOTA SEATS

W&R Directorate (GHQ) will make necessary arrangements for receiving online applications from candidates for W&R quota seats and their final selection within admission timelines.

REFUND POLICY

5.14 APPLICABILITY OF REFUND POLICY

This refund policy shall be applicable to candidates selected on open merit, foreign quota seat.

REFUND CASES

5.15 PROCESS FOR ADMISSION IN OTHER COLLEGE / WITHDRAWAL

- 5.15.1 If a student secures admission in NUMS and later he / she gets selected in MBBS / BDS in another University / College (not affiliated / attached with NUMS) or withdraw admission in any other case, the Refund will be given as follows:-
 - 5.15.1.1 Before joining the HITEC-IMS, amount (Rs. 250,000) deposited in NUMS will be refunded in full by NUMS.
 - 5.15.1.2 After joining the college, the amount (Rs. 250,000) deposited in NUMS and fee paid in HITEC-IMS will be refunded as per PM&DC / NUMS policy (refund policy displayed on website).

5.16 PROCESS FOR ADMISSION / TRANSFER IN HITÉC-IMS UPGRADATIONS

If a student secures admission in MBBS / BDS in one college and later he / she gets upgraded in MBBS / BDS to another NUMS Affiliated or attached

college, the fee will be transferred to that college without any deduction or delay.

5.17 GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.17.1 NUMS will send list of candidates (who have submitted admission acceptance fee) to HITEC-IMS.
- 5.17.2 HITEC-IMS will issue joining instructions and prescribed remaining fee challan to each provisionally selected candidate, with a due date of minimum three working days.
- 5.17.3 All admitted candidates will submit educational documents at the time of joining the HITEC-IMS along with attested copies of these documents.
- 5.17.4 Confirmation of admission will be subject to the scrutiny and verification of original identity and academic documents by the HITEC-IMS.
- 5.17.5 HITEC-IMS will send the list of candidates to NUMS (who have joined HITEC-IMS) after verifying the educational documents as per notified schedule by the NUMS.
- 5.17.6 HITEC-IMS will submit the data to University through PM&DC Online Portal.
- 5.17.7 After online submission of data through PM&DC online portal, HITEC-IMS will send the scanned copies of below mentioned documents via email in a prescribed manner:-
 - 5.17.7.1 IBCC verified SSC result / O level / 10th grade equivalence
 - 5.17.7.2 IBCC verified HSSC result / A level / 12th grade equivalence
 - 5.17.7.3 Copy of domicile for candidates selected on FATA / Gilgit Baltistan subsidized category seat
 - 5.17.7.4 Copy of UCAT / MDCAT result (in case of entrance test other than NUMS MDCAT)
 - 5.17.7.4 Along with above mentioned documents, HITEC-IMS will also submit an undertaking duly signed by the Principal that they have verified educational & personal documents of the finally admitted students.
 - 5.17.7.5 The university shall cancel any provisional admission where in the credentials of a student are not verified.
 - 5.17.7.6 The university will download the college wise list from PM&DC Online portal and verify the uploaded data on PM&DC online portal by comparing it with the NUMS

5.20 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

It is mandatory requirement for a candidate who wishes to apply for admission in NUMS / HITEC-IMS to fulfil the following eligibility criteria as a pre-requisite:-

OPEN MERIT SEATS

5.20.1 **PAKISTANI STUDENT** means a student who is a Pakistani national and has completed FSc / HSSC or equivalent in Pakistan. All other candidates who do not fall under this definition shall be treated as foreign student (having foreign nationality) for the purpose of admission.

- Pass percentage of MDCAT (NUMS) is 55% for admission in MBBS Program.
- 5.20.1.3 Result of last year's MDCAT (NUMS)-2023 shall not be valid for seeking admission in the Session 2024-25.
- 5.20.1.4 Minimum 60% aggregate marks in HSSC / FSc (Pre medical) or equivalent having minimum twelve years of education in atleast three subjects i.e Biology, Chemistry and either Physics or Mathematics.

FOREIGN SEATS

FOREIGN STUDENT means a student who holds a permanent Foreign nationality or is on overseas (being a Pakistani citizen permanently resident in a foreign country) Pakistani, and who has studied and passed HSSC 12th grade examination or equivalent from outside Pakistan and is a resident of a foreign

country at the time of applying for admission and possess a certificate to this effect from the institution last attended.

- 5.20.3 Pakistani MDCAT (NUMS)-2024 (held on 1st September, 2024) / Valid MCAT (USA) / Valid UCAT (UK).
- 5.20.4 Provided that the mandatory requirement of MDCAT shall not apply to students seeking admission on a special program seat predefined exclusively for foreign students and on the seats reserved for overseas Pakistanis. Such students shall qualify a foreign MCAT (USA) or UCAT (UK) Examination with 50% marks in the subjects of Biology, chemistry, and Physics / Mathematics.
- The applicant has passed minimum twelve years of education in atleast three subjects i.e. Biology, Chemistry and either Physics or Mathematics from a foreign university or examining body or foreign education system, and such course must have been duly certified by the Inter-Boards Coordination Commission (IBCC) with minimum 60 percent marks after equivalence.
- 5.20.6 It shall be the responsibility of the candidates having foreign qualifications to settle their cases with IBCC and should get equivalence certificate from IBCC for recognition of their qualification and score. For equivalence issues, please contact IBCC Head Office in Islamabad or Regional Offices.

5.21 AGE LIMIT

There is no minimum or maximum age limit for admission to a medical and dental college.

5.22 MERIT DETERMINATION WEIGHTAGE FORMULA FOR ADMISSION

The merit for the purpose of admissions shall be calculated as an Aggregate Percentage of marks determined by giving the following weightage to obtained marks of the candidate in different exams:-

GUIDELINES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

5.23 APPLICATION FORM

- 5.23.1 Information provided in application form by candidate will be deemed final.
- 5.23.2 Submission of application Form does not confer any right in respect of selection for admission, which shall only be granted on merit and as per choices / preferences
- 5.23.3 Revised marks of HSSC or Equivalent shall not be applicable after 22 November 2024.
- 5.23.4 If a candidate selects MBBS as 1st preference in application, the BDS choice will be auto-selected as 2nd preference and vice versa.
- 5.23.5 When filling up the online application, every applicants has to rank the medical and dental colleges in order of preference, starting with his / her first choice. Candidates are allowed to list up medical and dental colleges in the order that they would like to be considered for admission.
- 5.23.6 Selection of choices / preferences of program / colleges will be final and cannot be changed. Data provided by candidate will be used throughout the selection process for admission.
- 5.23.7 The application will be processed strictly on merit by preparing separate lists for private medical and dental colleges.

5.24 PROVISIONAL MERIT LIST

- 5.24.1 After the completion of online application process, NUMS will generate a provisional merit list for each of its respective affiliated and attached Medical and Dental College.
- 5.24.2 NUMS will display its provisional merit list of each affiliated and attached Medical / Dental College on official website.
- 5.24.3 The merit lists will be absolutely provisional and is subject to correction / revision / amendment in case of any error, omission, lapse, mistake, fraud or misrepresentation that occurs or is brought to the notice of University Authorities within due time.
- The candidates will be given 48 hours after the display of the Merit Lists to make complaints through registered email against any error, omission and lapse in the lists. After that no complaint will be entertained. In case of any discrepancy, candidates are advised to contact NUMS on designated email address mbbsbds.admissions@numspak.edu.pk (email received on any other email address will not be entertained).

5.25 SELECTION LIST

- 5.25.1 After all necessary corrections / rectifications, NUMS will display on its official website the 1st college Wise and category-wise Merit Lists keeping in view the number of seats on which admission is to be made.
- 5.25.2 Starting with the first preference, the applicant will be assessed and ranked on his / her merit.
- 5.25.3 According to his / her order of preference, if his / her first choice is taken and filled up by an applicant higher in merit, he / she will be considered for his / her next choice; and if that too is taken, he / she will be considered for his / her next choice. This will go until the candidate is placed in a college or all his / her choices are exhausted.
- 5.25.4 All those candidates who will be admitted to MBBS program being their first preference shall be excluded from the selection process for BDS program and vice versa.

5.26 PROVISIONAL ADMISSION

- 5.26.1 Candidates selected for admission shall be informed (as per sequence of aggregate merit) through SMS and Email. The candidates are advised to be vigilant and carefully check their registered email inbox (or spam folder) and can also find out their names in the selection lists according to their displayed on NUMS website.
- 5.26.2 No intimation to the applicants whatsoever about selection / nonselection will be sent other than the registered email address or contact Number by the university.
- 5.26.3 When a student accepts admission to a NUMS, he / she must disclose to NUMS, of the provision offer as well as acceptance of admission to other Colleges (Other than NUMS). Before accepting the later admission, the student must apply for cancellation of the previous. Failure to cancel acceptance of prior admission offer will render all admission offer as void and he / she will become ineligible for admission.
- 5.26.4 Selected candidates will be required to download their fee challan of Rs. 250,000 (Admission Acceptance Fee) from the NUMS application portal. They will be required to deposit the fee in the nearest branch of HBL by due date mentioned on their fee challan.
- 5.26.5 Selected candidates shall be given three (03) working days to deposit the prescribed fee after the display the selection list.

- 5.26.6 Those who fail to deposit their fee within due date shall be excluded from the admission / upgradation process and shall have no right of admission / upgradation into the said program in the current session and the next applicant on the waiting merit list will be offered admission in order to facilitate timely completion of admission process.
- 5.26.7 Candidates admitted to their 1st preference are excluded from subsequent rounds. Candidate selected on their first preference will need to report the college as per the provided schedule by NUMS to received their joining letter and make the payment for admission confirmation. Their names will then be finalized for that college.
- 5.26.8 Candidates selected for their second, third, fourth, and subsequent preferences may be upgraded or transferred to a college ranked higher in their preference list until all choices are exhausted, if a seat becomes available and their merit aligns with that of the college. NUMS will communicate the joining date to the candidates for the selected college.

5.27 UPGRADATION

- 5.27.1 The candidate getting selected in previous list will be considered for upgradation in the subsequent list. The up-gradation herein means shift on merit to a college named higher in the preference order by the candidate in case of creation of vacancy in that college.
- 5.27.2 Right of up-gradation shall be given to only those candidates who have paid (Admission acceptance fee) in the preceding list. A candidate who is selected but does not pay fee within due date, he / she shall not eligible for further selection process / up-gradation.
- 5.27.3 The candidate shall only be up-graded to a college he / she has listed in his / her order of preference in case a seat is available and the merit of the candidate corresponds with that of the college.
- 5.27.4 If candidate considered for upgradation in subsequent lists, there will be mandatory shift to a college ranked higher preference order and no exceptions will be made under any circumstances.

5.28 JOINING OF SELECTED CANDIDATES TO HITEC-IMS & PAYMENT OF REMAINING FEE

- 5.28.1 NUMS Will display on its website the college wise list of provisionally admitted candidates and same will be sent to college.
- 5.28.2 Provisionally admitted candidates will report to college as per schedule issued by college.
- 5.28.3 The college will provide them with them with joining instructions and details regarding the remaining fee to be paid for admission finalization
- 5.28.4 The candidates will pay the remaining fee and other dues after the completion of admission process at the college where his / her admission has been finalized.
- 5.28.5 All admitted candidates shall have to submit all original documents at the time of joining in the medical / dental college for which they have been admitted along with attested copies of these documents.
- 5.28.6 Confirmation of admission will be subject to the payment of remaining fee, scrutiny and verification of original identity and academic documents by the College.
- 5.28.7 Candidates who do not report to the college / submit the remaining fee to the college by due date, his / her provisional admission will be cancelled and will not be considered for any further selection / upgradation.

5.29 GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.29.1 There will be no request or claim for mutual transfer, status retention, or down gradation under any circumstances.
- 5.29.2 If candidate admitted against Open Merit as well as category seat, he / she will avail only one seat by choice and let the other seat forgo, by submitting a written statement.
- 5.29.3 Whenever two or more than two candidates are bracketed, i.e., they have exactly the same aggregate percentage after calculation, the tie shall be broken in the following steps (in the same order):-
 - 5.29.3.1 The one senior in age will be given preference.
 - 5.29.3.2 The one having higher marks in MDCAT will be given preference.
 - 5.29.3.3 The one having higher marks in HSSC / equivalent 12th grade examination will be given preference

5.30 ADMISSION ON VACANT SEAT

- 5.30.1 When already admitted in any public / private medical and dental college, candidate cannot not claim admission through vacant seat policy of PM&DC to any NUMS affiliated / attached college.
- 5.30.2 Candidate who is admitted in private sector dental college shall be eligible for admission on vacant seat in private sector medical college only.

5.31 REFUND POLICY

- 5.30.1 If a student secures admission in NUMS and later he / she gets selected in MBBS / BDS in another University / College (Not Affiliated / Attached with NUMS) or withdraw admission in any other case, the Refund will be given as follow:-
 - 5.30.1.1 Before joining the College, amount (Rs.250,000) deposited in NUMS will be refunded in full by University
 - 5.30.1.2 After joining the college, the amount (Rs.250,000) deposited in NUMS and fee paid in college will be refunded as per PM&DC / NUMS policy. The refund policy is displayed on HITEC-IMS official website.
- 5.30.2 If a student secures admission in MBBS / BDS in one college and later he / she gets upgraded in MBBS / BDS to another NUMS Affiliated or Attached College, the fee will be transferred to that college without any deduction.
