TUITION FEE-NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of the recommendations of the Committee on Medical Education constituted by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of Pakistan, in its meetings held on 27th March, 2025 and 18th December, 2025, and in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 20(8) of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council Act, 2022, the Council, after due deliberation, has considered the requests of private medical and dental institutions for enhancement of tuition fees.

2. Upon careful examination of the recommendations of the Fee Justification Committee and scrutiny of the audited financial statements for FY-2025 submitted by the respective institutions, the Council has unanimously resolved to approve the following tuition fee caps, as specified against each institution:


Terms & Conditions:

- i. **Applicability:** The approved enhancement shall take effect from Session 2024–25 and shall apply uniformly to all professional years (First Professional to Final Professional).
- ii. **One-Time Enhancement:** The enhancement hereby approved is strictly one-time in nature and shall be deemed to cover the entire remaining duration of the MBBS and BDS programmes of students currently enrolled. No further increase shall be permissible during the said duration.
- iii. **Bar on Additional Increase:** Institutions granted enhancement under this notification shall not be entitled to claim, levy, or impose any additional five percent (5%) increase for Session 2025–26.
- iv. **Refund / Adjustment of Excess Fee:** Any amount charged or collected in excess of the approved fee cap shall be refunded or adjusted in favour of the students of Sessions 2024–25 and 2025–26 within one (01) month from the date of issuance of this notification, under written intimation to PM&DC.
- v. **CPI-Based Adjustment:** Any adjustment on account of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) from Session 2026–27 onward shall be notified separately by PM&DC and shall be subject to regulatory approval.
- vi. **Publication Requirement:** All concerned institutions shall prominently display this notification on their official websites and notice boards to ensure transparency and public awareness.

- vii. **Prohibition of Excess Charging:** Any tuition fee structure displayed, advertised, demanded, or charged in excess of the above-notified caps shall be deemed unlawful and in violation of the Act. All non-compliant information shall be removed from official websites within seven (07) working days from the date of issuance of this notification.
- viii. **Regulatory Action:** Any contravention of this notification shall attract action under Section 33 of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council Act, 2022, including but not limited to suspension of accreditation and/or admissions.
- ix. **Penalty:** A monetary penalty up to PKR 2,000,000 (Rupees Two Million Only) may be imposed for each violation, in respect of each individual complaint reported to PM&DC by a student or parent.
- x. **Audit Compliance:** Institutions shall engage audit firms possessing valid Quality Control Review (QCR) ratings issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP). With effect from FY-2026 onward, only audit reports issued by QCR-rated firms shall be accepted by PM&DC for regulatory purposes.
- xi. Any excess amount collected shall be refunded or adjusted in favor of the students concerned within one (01) month of issuance of this notification, under intimation to PM&DC.

6. This notification shall have binding effect and shall be complied with, in letter and spirit, by all concerned institutions forthwith.
